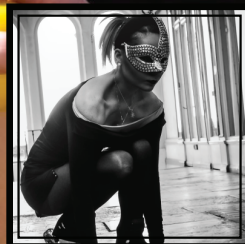

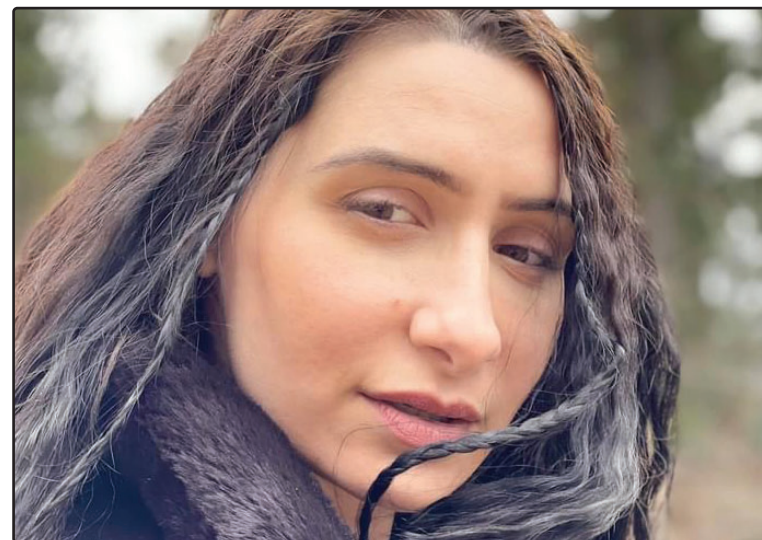

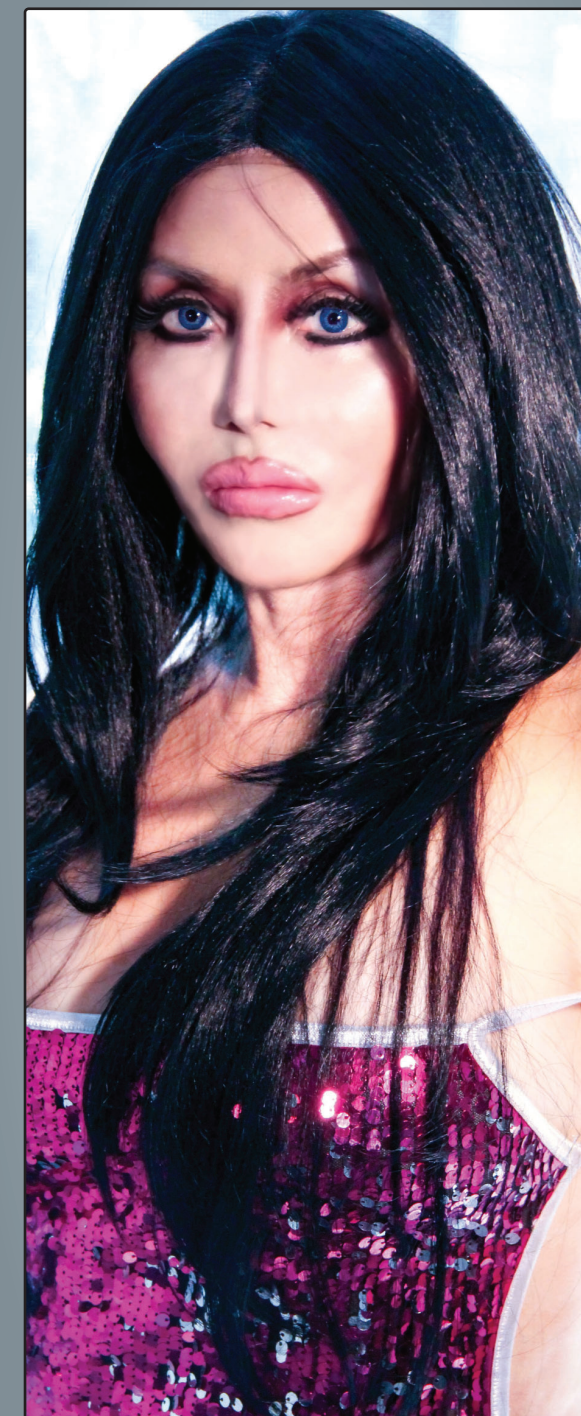

My brother and I, were some of the 100 or so kids accepted into the program, but being young and growing up somewhat poor, it was hard to get to the classes. We ended up quitting shortly thereafter. That didn't deter me from pursuing art. I knew that I wanted to do something with art. It wasn't until I joined the

Marine Corps, that things started to "make sense" to me. It dawned on me that I could do something with my art. After contemplation and a little self doubt, I took a little sketch of a tattoo concept I had drawn for myself, into a tattoo shop. The artist had used my design to create my tattoo. It was at that moment, I realized I could possibly pursue a career in the tattoo industry. A way to do what I love to make a living for my family and I seemed like a dream worth investing in. Not really knowing where to start, I got a few more tattoos to see if it was something I could seriously get into, enough to pursue diligently. Years & many internet searches later, led me to putting together a more

professional portfolio to present. Luckily, one of my buddies had got a tattoo from a local Tattoo studio, Evolved Body Arts, and mentioned they had a versatile group of artists there. I figured it may be the place to start, and present my portfolio. I took my portfolio there and this talented tattoo artist, Chad Miskimon, gave me a shot and I ran with it. Many years later, here I am, I am thankful for the opportunity I was given, and I try to progress my art and give every client that instills their trust in me, the best tattoo possible. If you have read up to this point, I am humbled and thankful that you somehow stumbled upon me.

She also practiced gymnastic, rhythmic gymnastic and ballet dancing but skating was always the sport number one for her. In her early teens Sarah competed in national level, and was give the opportunity to switch to pair skating and trained in the city of Caen with the high level coach Jean-François

Ballester. With her former partner, Pavel Savinov, and their coach Stoyan Kazakov she trained in Sofia, in Bulgaria and she was part of the national bulgarian team. On the side, Sarah is also interested about art and fashion and always paid particular attention to her education. She succeed to obtain two bachelor degree in university, one in Sport Management and an other one in Economy as well as a Master degree of Journalism at the superior school of journalism in Paris. In 2014, she decided to take a turn over in her carrer and started skating ice shows all around the world with Disney On Ice and was part of three different production.
